SEVERAL CHANGES HAVE BEEN MADE IN THE SYSTEM FOR AWARDING POINTS FOR COMPETITION IN REGIONAL ACTIVITIES, YOUR ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE HAVE MADE THESE CHANGES IN ORDER TO CREATE COMPETITION AND TO MAKE THE EVENTS MORE INTERESTING. EACH MEMBER WHO ATTENDS A SCHEDULED REGIONAL EVENT WILL RECEIVE POINTS WHETHER HE COMPETES OR NOT. IN ADDITION, COMPETITION POINTS WILL BE AWARDED ON THE FOLLOWING CLASS BASIS.

PRIZES ARE SET UP FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL EVENT ACCORDING TO THE TYPE OF EVENT AND THE CARS ENTERED. ALSO, 10 POINTS WILL BE AWARDED TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE EVENT AND 5 POINTS TO HIS AIDS. THESE POINTS WILL NOT BE AWARDED IF THE CREW CAN ACTUALLY PARTICIPATE IN THE COMPETITION. IN ANY CASE, A MAXIMUM OF 10 POINTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ANY MEMBER AT A PARTICULAR EVENT. IN A LADIES EVENT, 10 POINTS WILL BE AWARDED TO LADIES WHERE THE EVENT CALLS FOR A LADIES CLASS.

LETTER FROM THE R.E.

SUNDAY, AFTERNOON, DECEMBER 23, THE FOLLOWING REGIONAL OFFICERS MET TO DISCUSS AND STRUCTURE THE FRAMEWORK FOR THE ORGANIZATION'S 1957 ACTIVITY YEAR: ASST. DIR. JOE LOYD, ACT. DIRECTOR SANDY DOWNS, ASST. ACT. DIR. JOE MAYER, AND MYSELF. IN ATTENDANCE WERE ROLLY STYSKAL AND DAVE HOLLENBAUGH. I'D LIKE TO BRING UP THE HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS GATHERING, WHICH POINT UP THE "NEW LOOK" CHANGES WE ARE GIVING TO NEBRASKA REGIONAL MATTERS.

PROBABLY OF GREATEST SIGNIFICANCE IS THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF A NEW NEBRASKA REGIONAL AWARD, THE WOODY DUNN MEMORIAL TROPHY, TO BE PRESENTED ANNUALLY TO THE MEMBER DEEMED MOST VALUABLE TO THE CLUB THROUGHOUT THE PRECEDING YEAR. THIS IS A PERPETUAL OR TRAVELING TROPHY, GOLD AND WHITE, TWO FEET HIGH, VERY IMPRESSIVE. THE IDEA FOR THIS RECOGNITION CAME FROM ROLLY STYSKAL AND DAVE HOLLENBAUGH. ROLLY TOLD US THAT HE HAS PURCHASED THE TROPHY, WITH THE INTENTION OF DONATING IT TO THE REGION. EVERYONE WHO KNEW WOODY WILL APPRECIATE THE THOUGHT BEHIND THE AWARD, AND WILL UNDERSTAND WHY SUCH A SIGNIFICANT TROPHY SHOULD BEAR THE NAME OF THIS LATE AND GREAT NEBRASKA MEMBER. OUR DEEPEST AND MOST SINCERE THANKS TO ROLLY AND DAVE.

EVERY NEBRASKA REGION MEMBER IS ENCOURAGED TO DO EVERYTHING IN HIS POWER TO PROMOTE THE PUBLIC'S INTEREST IN, AND APPRECIATION OF SPORTS CARS. THE ACTIVITIES DIRECTOR AND HIS ASSISTANT HAVE BEEN CHARGED WITH THE RESPONSIBILITY OF SEEING TO IT THAT REGIONAL EVENTS ARE HELD EACH MONTH ACCORDING TO WHOM THEY HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED, AT THE TIME SPECIFIED, AND WITH THE NECESSARY PERSONNEL. THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT SANDY DOWNS AND JOE MAYER ARE GOING TO GO AND RUN EACH OF THE YEAR'S EVENTS. IT DOES MEAN, HOWEVER, THAT THEY'LL PROBABLY BE CALLING YOU, ASKING THAT YOU ARRANGE, OR HELP ARRANGE, AT LEAST ONE OF OUR MONTHLY OUTINGS. WE URGE EVERYONE TO COOPERATE FULLY. ACTING AS MUCH FUN TO PLAN AND RUN THESE AFFAIRS AS IT IS TO PARTICIPATE.

ASSISTANT ACTIVITIES DIRECTOR JOE MAYER WILL BE PRODUCING THE NEWSLETTER. I'M WELL AWARE THAT HE HAS LET HIMSELF IN FOR EVERYTHING. EVERYONE SHOULD COOPERATE FULLY WITH HIM BY HELPING HIM IN THIS EXTRA RESPONSIBILITY. ALL ITEMS FOR PUBLICATION SHOULD BE IN JOE'S HANDS NOT LATER THAN THE 20TH OF EACH MONTH.

THE FOLLOWING HAVE BEEN APPOINTED AS CONTEST BOARD REPRESENTATIVES; RYAN KATSKEE, CHAIRMAN; JOE MAYER; AND JIM LOYD.

NEBRASKA REGION OFFICERS WILL HOLD A MEETING IMMEDIATELY AT THE CONCLUSION OF EACH MONTHLY EVENT. ANY MEMBER HAVING SOMETHING TO PRESENT, SHOULD BRING IT WITH THE OFFICERS AT ONE OF THESE INFORMAL GATHERINGS. IT IS OUR INTENTION THAT THROUGH THIS TECHNIQUE ALL MATTERS WILL HAVE THE FULL ATTENTION OF THE OFFICERS, AND THAT ONLY THOSE ITEMS REQUIRING CONSIDERATION BY THE ENTIRE MEMBERSHIP WILL BE BROUGHT BEFORE IT FOR DISCUSSION. FURTHER, THOSE MATTERS PRESENTED IN OPEN MEETINGS WILL HAVE BEEN THOROUGHLY THRASHED OUT IN ADVANCE BY THE OFFICERS, AND CAN THEN BE INTRODUCED WITH RECOMMENDATIONS AS TO COURSES OF ACTION WHICH MAY BE FOLLOWED. WE FEEL YOU WILL LIKE THIS SYSTEM VERY MUCH. IT WILL STREAMLINE GENERAL MEETING, SO A SMALLER PORTION OF THE MEETING WILL BE DEVOTED TO WHAT HAVE SOMETIMES BEEN RATHER LENGTHY AND NECESSARY DISCUSSIONS OF ROUTINE MATTERS OF REGIONAL BUSINESS.

THIS COMPLETES OUR REVIEW OF THE NEBRASKA REGION'S FIRST PLANS AND PROGRAM FOR 1957. WE HOPE YOU'LL APPROVE OF THE MOVES WE'VE MADE. IF YOU HAVE ANY VALUABLE SUGGESTIONS TO ADD, OR CONSTRUCTIVE CRITICISMS TO OFFER, PLEASE FEEL FREE TO WRITE TO ME, OR ANY OTHER OFFICER. IF YOU WOULD RATHER STATE YOUR IDEAS ORALLY, MAKE A POINT OF APPEARING AT ONE OF THE OFFICERS MEETINGS. YOU CAN BE CERTAIN THAT YOUR VIEWS WILL RECEIVE EVERYONE'S FULL ATTENTION AND CONSIDERATION.
