LOCATION:

The Yankee Hill Brick Yards can be reached by following U.S. Highway 46 (bypass) around Lincoln to the intersection with West "O" Street. Continue West on "O" Street for one mile and turn south across the railroad viaduct. Proceed South past Pioneer Park and look for the tall chimney to the right of the road. Turn in thru the brick piles till you see a friendly face.

REGULATIONS:

1. Entry Fee of 50¢ per driver should be enclosed with entry blank and mailed to J.E. Loyd, P.O. Box 1161, Lincoln, Nebraska, As Soon As Possible.
2. Entries are limited to S.C.C.A. Members Only and their families excluding children under 21 years of age. The Corporation owning the property will refuse entry to all minors.
3. FIRST PLACE TROPHIES will be awarded to the following classes.

a. Under 1200 cc	d. 1500 cc to 2700 cc
b. 1200 cc to 1300 cc	e. 2700 cc and over
c. 1300 cc to 1500 cc	f. Special Powder Puff Award
4. Safety belts properly installed, and adequate crash helmets, are MANDATORY. Limited number of helmets will be available for use at the event if you don't have one.
5. In the event of rain or inclement weather, an alternate Rally has been planned which will start from the Brick Yards at 11:00 a.m.
