### A GYMKANA TO BEAT ALL GYMKANAS!

On Sunday, September 11, 1960, the September event, will be held as the Second Annual Economart Gymkana. The parking lot has been tripled in size and a slightly different type of event will be produced.

This will be a speed gymkana, driver type. No navigator will be required but may be used on one phase. The course will be divided into four sections, each section requiring two to four minutes. This will provide each contestant with ten to fifteen minutes of driving. Two of the sections will be scaled down versions of European road circuits. One section will be of a gimmick nature and will be a good test of car balance. There will be a division of cars into classes based upon engine displacement. Trophies will be in great abundance with four to six trophies in each class. Also a powder-puff class will be run. Plus, a new traveling trophy for best over all time will be presented. In conjunction with the gymkana, several dealers will provide cars for a sports car show.

Because of the circuit involved, the course will be published in advance and will be given out at the August events. They will also be available at Omaha Volkswagen, Mid-West Sports Car Center, Omaha Imports, and at Mike Lemmers' in Courtryside Village.
