Election Issue

The attendance at the quarterly meeting of the Nebraska Region of the S.C.C.A. held at the Gourmet Restaurant, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 16, 1961, was limited mostly to those members living in Omaha. Therefore, it was felt that the membership of the Club should be informed of the nominations and nominating procedure as discussed at the meeting on Saturday night.

Mike Lemmers, who presided at the meeting, introduced Al Bebout as chairman of the nominating committee. The following is what Al had to say:

"The nominating committee did some genuine soul searching in the pursuit of its slate. Our reasons for belonging to the S.C.C.A. were examined and only those nominees were selected who we felt would be able to make a full contribution to the individual members' needs.

"We looked at some of our past mistakes and sought someone who we thought could avoid repeating these.

"But most of all, with full credit to all the membership who have done lots and lots of time consuming tasks for the region, we looked for a slate of officers who were compatible and who would be willing to take on the heavy work load entailed in maintaining and building this Region.

"Therefore, the nominating committee respectfully submits the following persons to the membership as officer candidates of the Nebraska Region 48, Area 6, Sports Car Club of America, for these reasons:

- A. Each of them with full knowledge of the responsibility and work entailed, believes himself able to devote sufficient time to the job.
- B. Each has the capacity and conveniences to complete his work.
- C. Each is in possession of a genuine deep feeling for and appreciation of the reasons for S.C.C.A. and is therefore willing to give of himself for the membership.
- D. All candidates are inter-emotionally stabilized - can get along together; thus will work together.
- E. The nominees have been selected from geographic areas in a manner compatible with efficient correspondence and good member communication.

2. Emphasize membership, member communication, Exhaust Notes, public relations, and do their best to further build the Region.

1. Have a lot more spare time than they would have had if elected."

The nominating committee was appointed by R. E., Bill Jurgensen. This committee has nominated a single slate of officers. Any member who doesn't like the slate of officers listed above can nominate another candidate for any one office, or can nominate another complete slate of officers. This may be done by petition, naming the person, office, and signed by ten (10) members of the Nebraska Region.

These petitions must be in the hands of the Secretary, Wil Mead, 9710 Woodridge Lane, Omaha, Nebraska, by the 26th of September, 1961.

This is the legal procedure according to the By-Laws of the Club.

So if you have a candidate in mind for any one particular office, or if you would like to nominate a whole slate other than the one above, **BE SURE** to have your petition, signed by ten members, in Wil Mead's hands by the 26th of September. Stand up and be counted.
