WE ARE going to have a CENTENNIAL RALLY 1gn

Do you listen to the weather forecasts? --10% chance of rain--20% chance of rain--80% chance of snow. Ever wonder how it was done? Really; its quite simple. We have here 11 weather men. One is in charge. Every time we need a weather forecast the number one man calls the other ten together and says, "How many of you think it is going to rain tomorrow?"
