and How They Work...

10 points for participating in an NRSCCA points event.

10 points for participating in an SCCA event on the same day as an NRSCCA points event.

10 points for EVENT MASTER - only once and counts as working.

9 points for CO-EVENT MASTER - only once and counts as working.

8 points for WORKER - maximum of 4 times of any combination.

10 to 0 points for placement within class; 10 for 1st and 0 for 11th.

100% CLUB

Must participate in ALL NRSCCA points events.

SOLO II DRIVER

10 to 0 points for placement within class for NRSCCA Solo II events, Divisional and National Runoffs.

RALLY DRIVER AND NAVIGATOR

10 to 0 points for placement within class for NRSCCA TSD points events (class C does not receive points), Divisional and National rallies (all classes). Maximum of 2 Divisional and/or National rallies will count.

Points standings will be published from time to time in the Exhaust Notes. Questions and complaints must be filed with the pointskeeper within 30 days; otherwise, the points become final.

Workers (and participants) must sign the liability waiver in order to get activities points and credit for 100% club.

NRSCCA CURRENT RALLY POLICY

The regional rally classes are:

A - EQUIPPED - for rallyists with unlimited equipment including calculators, tables and slide rules.

B - SEAT-OF-THE-PANTS - "pencil and paper" only, as well as any watch whose rate cannot easily be varied to aid in computation.

C - NOVICE - seat-of-the-pants for rallyists with less than one year's experience.

See points article for driver and navigator end-of-year trophies.

The rallymaster of a points TSD rally shall receive, only once a year, first place (10) points toward either the driver or navigator award.

NOTICE TO ALL 1982 EVENT MASTERS

It is my job to remind you all that you need to get results in to me within 7 days of your event or you will lose your activities points for putting on the event. It is my request that you get results to me in the following manner:

Rallys:

I need the names of event master, assistant and all workers. I need the names of all participants and whether they drove or navigated. I need the class they ran in. (A, B or C.) I would like to have the make and color of car they drove. I would like to have the leg scores along with the total.

Solo IIs:

I need the names of event master, assistant and all workers. I need the names of all participants. I need the class they ran in. I would like to have the make and color of car they drove. I need their best (or winning) times. I need to know who wins (or won) a trophy and which classes were combined.

All of this is so those who read the results can get the maximum out of reading them. Everybody likes to see not just who's winning, but what's winning. I appreciate your cooperation.
