For the uninformed rallyist, a Hare & Hound rally is where the event master is the "Hare" and the rally cars are the "Hounds". Simple? The Hare goes first and leaves a trail for the Hounds to follow. This may be lime on the road or whatever (such as pie plates) which mark the intersections at which the rally cars need to make a decision. If the correct decision was made, the rallyist will see a confirmation marker of the same type as marked the intersection. If an incorrect decision was made, there will be no confirmation, and the rallyist must chose again. The object is to follow the course making the least number of incorrect decisions and therefore having the least number of miles accumulated.

This rally may count as a TSD (Time, Speed, Distance) rally for the year end trophies, but as yet this has not been decided. There will be a party following.

A HERRINGBONE rally is so named by the look of the instructions. The rally route is a straight line drawn on paper with roads going off of it which you do not travel on. Since obviously a rally route itself is not a straight line, this is a challenging event to run. A point of interest about this rally is that every single intersection that you encounter is marked on the instructions. More about this type of event in next months issue of Exhaust Notes. Plan to attend!
