RESTRUCTURED LOWER CLASSES FOR 1982 SOLO II SEASON

A word of warning: the Nebraska Region will be using the proposed rules for the lower stock classes. This means that your car might not run in the class that it did last year. (Bd Note: or the class for which it is listed in the 1982 Solo II Rules Book - even though we revert to those classes for the run-offs.) A list of classes and changes were printed in the May 1982 issue of Sports Car. If you didn't belong to SCCA at the time the map was printed (or don't bother to read Sports Car) you don't know where you will run in 1982, so here is

A List of Changes:

D Stock - ADDED - BMW 320I, Fiat 124 Coupe & Spyder.

E Stock - ADDED - Chevette, Dodge Fire Arrow, Isuzu (Opel) - 1800 & 2000, Opel 1900 Sedan

F Stock - ADDED - Corvair (all)

G Stock - LOSTS - most former G cars except - Audi Fox 5+5 & Coupe, Dodge Charger 2.2, Colt (5 speed), Flesta, Civic 1980 & up 1500, Champ (5 speed), Rabbit & Scirocco.

H Stock - All most everything else - Buick Skylark (4 cyl), Citation (4), Camaro V6, Monza V6, Pinto & Bobcat V6, Omega 4, and Starfire V6.
