Fall is once again Rally time in Nebraska. The summer Solo II season is over. If you have rallied in the past, last summer or spring; or if you want to get started new, now is the time. There are 3 Rallys this fall:

Mac's Midnight Madness Mk XI by John Ely	9/29/85
Rally by Kendahl & Janean Shane	10/20/85
Rally by Jerry & Ellen Doctor	11/10/85

The first of these, MMMMK XI, is an old tradition in the region, first run in February, 1966. It's a monster. Registration is from 10 P.M. to midnight Saturday night the 28th. The rally itself runs from midnight to breakfast Sunday morning. It will cover at least 250 miles and three or more states. It is a simple TSD rally but obviously, stamina will be a deciding factor in winning. You will need: a sound car with good lights, an interior light to read instructions, spare change for gas, rest stops and toll bridges, and some sleep ahead of time, and maps. If you are a beginner, I strongly advise you to call me, 342-5742, and pre-register. I will try to get you a copy of the General Instructions early so that you may study them. Mac's is not easy. It is fun.

Finally, Those of you members who do not rally, please call on of the above rallymasters and offer your help to work on a checkpoint. After all the rally people help the solo people put on events all summer, it's the least you can do.
