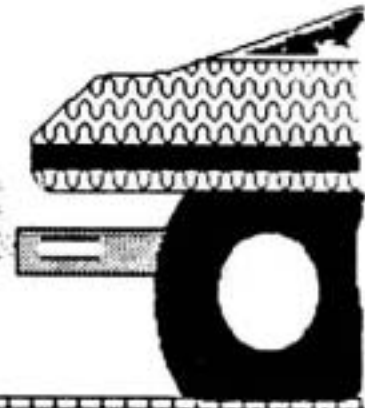

This rally is of the Monte Carlo style. Instead of being given speeds to average, the route instructions give the time required for each leg of the rally. These times are given in minutes and hundreths of a minute (NOT seconds). In order to make it easier for you to stay "on time", you are also given the time at which each route instruction should be executed. The locations of the checkpoints are given in the route instructions. The mileage at which each instruction should be executed is given in the route instructions. Milages are measured from the beginning of each leg. Times are also given from the beginning of each leg. Sound too good to be true? There's a reason for the name of this rally and it has nothing to do with the weather in November. The speeds used to calculate the times given to you are based on 90% of posted speeds. (80% if weather is bad.) This makes the speeds you need to maintain brisk at best. You are obviously not asked to exceed the speed limits, you must, however, stay on the rally route to stay on time. And you must obviously maintain the speeds and not stop to argue about which way to go at an intersection. We will lead you through all "trap" intersections by telling you which way to go and referring you to the appropriate general instruction which causes your action. Hopefully, some of you new ralliests can use this as a learning experience as well as a fun afternoon. The rally route will be all on paved roads, so, weather permitting, you can bring your nice cars out. After the rally we urge you to join us at Sortino's at 79th and "L" Streets. A note of interest - after the first BBBrisk event one of the entrants came up to us and asked if we would leave the checkpoints out - cause he wanted to go again!

Please get your reservations in early and save the social chairman from wearing out his dialing fingers culling everyone at the last minute to get reservations.
