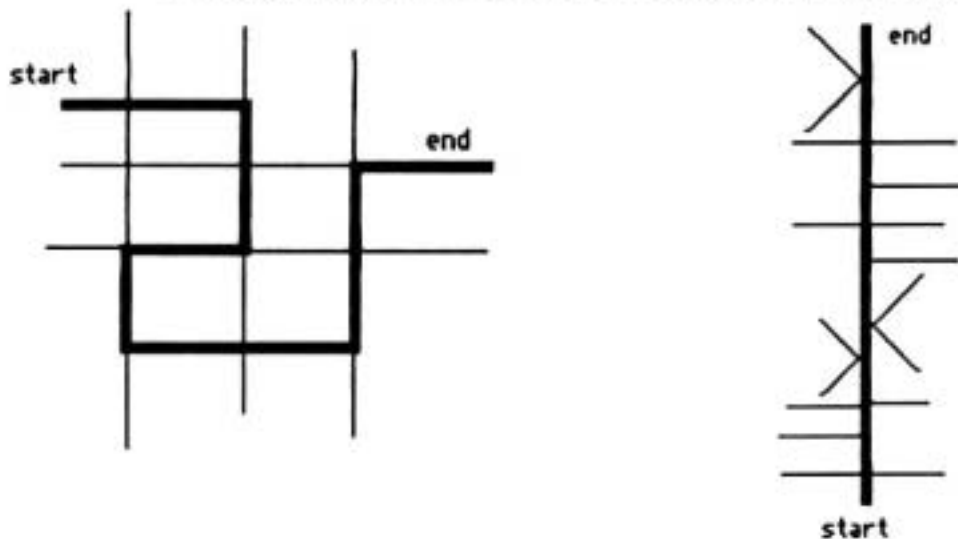

Brief Overview of a Herringbone Rally

Basically, a Herringbone Rally is where the route is drawn and then the two ends of the route are held and pulled straight. Example below:



The roads pictured on the left are the "map" version of the route - the drawing on the right is the route instructions which show all of the roads not taken. The instructions are read simply leave a road on either side, leave a road on the left, etc. Herringbones look harder than they are. Every road you encounter must be pictured, therefore it is a lot less hard to get lost on a Herringbone. I hope this will help you see what you will be getting into.
