Nominations for the Board of Governors election have closed. Nebraska Region members will soon receive a ballot in the mail. Carefully read and follow the directions that come with the ballot. Every year we have to discard several ballots because of voters that did not correctly follow the procedure. Your selection of who should serve on the BoG is an important one. Don't waste your vote.

Nominations are just beginning from members of the Nebraska Region to determine who will receive two of the most prestigious year-end awards. Several years ago the procedure for selecting the recipients of the Workers Cup and the Woody Dunn Trophy were changed. The winners are now selected by the Board of Governors from a list of nominees submitted by members of the region. If there are no nominees the awards are not presented.

The Workers Cup was created in 1981 to recognize the outstanding worker at regional events. First presented in 1956, the Woody Dunn Trophy is the Nebraska Region's oldest year-end award. It honors a member that has made an outstanding contribution to the region. Both awards are intended to recognize the efforts of a member doing more than carrying out the duties of an officer of the club. Chuck Garcia was awarded the Worker's Cup for 2003. The Woody Dunn Trophy was presented to the Nebraska Region History Team.

Nominations must be submitted to me, the NRSCCA Regional Executive, in writing. The nomination must include an explanation of why the nominee deserves to receive the award. Any member in good standing of the Nebraska Region may submit a nomination for either or both awards. The deadline is November 11, one week prior to the November Board of Governors meeting. You'll find my address on page 2 of this newsletter. You can also submit your letter of nomination by e-mail.

NEBRASKA REGION HISTORY

PATT BUELL, REGIONAL HISTORIAN

By the time NRSCCA was into the late 1970's, the membership had grown to almost 100 members. Event participation was strong, with 60 or more cars at slaloms, sometimes 15-20 cars at rallies and about 15 or so race drivers.

These are the people who put on the events, worked them and participated in them. They held offices and chairmanships and some served on the Board of Governors.

They wrote articles for the Exhaust Notes. They won event awards and year end awards. This is what Nebraska region is about.



We still have about 30 or more of these folks from 1954 to 1980 that are still around today.

So when I think of the early decades, these are the faces that come to mind. Hopefully, I have not missed anyone. If I did, it was not intentional.

(Not pictured: Mervin M. Neher and Jeff M. Schweid - I could not find any pictures of them, but they are still NRSCCA members today.)

These are the folks who have contributed to the club and the history web site (nrscchistory.com). Some have loaned photos, others told us stories and gave us support. Most of these people are still members. I would like to thank them all.

SCCA DISCONTINUES STAGE-BASED RALLY

TOPEKA, Kan. (Oct. 5, 2004) – Sports Car Club of America's Board of Directors voted Monday to discontinue the sanction of its current stage-based rally format, including the ProRally and ClubRally Championships, beginning January 1, 2005 due to increasing risk exposure.

"This was a difficult and unfortunate decision to make," SCCA Board of Directors Chairman Gary Pitts said. "However, from an insurance standpoint, the stage rally format has gotten to the point where it puts the entire Club, its activities and entities under an undue risk."

"We have many SCCA members whose interests lie in rally," SCCA President and CEO Steve Johnson said. "It is my intent to allow these members the opportunity to rally in the future and continue to access the sport. I am confident we can accomplish this task."

"We are in negotiations to transition SCCA's elements of the stage-based rally activity to Rally America, a longtime partner and participant in the sport of rally."

Unaffected by the decision are SCCA's RallyCross and RoadRally programs.

SCCA began its special stage-format ProRally Championship in 1973. Since then, the ProRally Championship Presented by Hot Wheels has been regarded as the top domestic rally series. The 2004 Championship has one round remaining, Lake Superior ProRally (LSPR), which will run as scheduled Oct. 22 in Houghton, Mich.

SCCA & RALLY AMERICA MEETINGS PROGRESS

TOPEKA, Kan. (Oct. 8, 2004) – Sports Car Club of America and Rally America officials met Thursday, discussing the transition of the ProRally and ClubRally programs from SCCA to Rally America.

After the productive talks closed, several key components of the transition, including rules, licensing and tentative scheduling had been resolved.

"Our meeting with SCCA was extremely productive," said President of Rally America Doug Havar. "I would like to personally thank Steve Johnson and his staff for helping to make this transition as smooth as possible. They are doing absolutely everything within their power to assist Rally America, and because both sides are working toward a common goal, I have no doubt that rally in the United States will grow stronger than ever."

Havar also said that Rally America is currently in negotiations with multiple insurance brokers. After discussions were completed Thursday, the following agreements were set for 2005:

- Rally America will begin issuing its own competition licenses Jan. 1, 2005, and will honor current SCCA competition licenses until their expiration date.

- Rally America will use the 2005 SCCA rule book, event operations manual, log books and class structure.

- Competitors who hold a valid SCCA membership will receive a rebate on their event entry fee in 2005.

- Rally America plans on releasing a 2005 rally schedule at the SCCA Lake Superior ProRally event (Oct. 23-24), the final round of the SCCA ProRally Championship Presented by Hot Wheels®.
