## Dead Driver Formerly Of Lincoln Base

OAKLAND, Ia. (AP) — Woodbury Dunn, 26, of Princeton, N.J., formerly stationed at the Lincoln (Neb.) Air Force Base was killed instantly Thursday night in a head-on car-truck crash on Highway 6 near here.

Dunn was driving a small car of German make with Nebraska license plates when the accident occurred. The driver of the truck, Gene Snyder of Emmetsburg, Ia., escaped injury.

Lt. David Hallanbaugh of the 98th Bomb Wing at the Lincoln Base said Friday that Dunn was his former roommate. He added that Dunn left the Lincoln base about two months ago for school in Chicago.

Lt. Hallanbaugh said Dunn was en route to Lincoln for a visit when the accident occurred. Dunn was an Air Force lieutenant while stationed at Lincoln.

Iowa State Highway Patrolmen said the car was crumpled into a little heap of wreckage. Patrolmen said the head-on collision occurred as Snyder was passing another truck.
